AWDis TIPS	<p>Our Recycled Polyester fabric has a textured, tight knit surface, which is a great base for achieving even and smooth prints while using a minimal amount of ink, thus reducing your environmental impact.</p> <p>Make sure you use an anti-migration layer on those brighter colours to avoid colour migration to lighter colours and prints.</p> <p>Avoid prints cracking by curing at the correct temperature and time – always test print and cure.</p> <p>Monitor your temperature, polyester can burn and scorch if cured too high!</p> <p>*Consider environmentally friendly screen printing inks.</p>	Not Recommended	Not Recommended	Not Recommended	<p>Our soft textured surface of the Recycled Polyester styles ensures smooth and seamless transfer print.</p> <p>Make your design pop by experimenting with full colour, glitter, flock, foil and rhinestones for a unique look.</p> <p>Monitor your temperature, polyester can burn and scorch if cured too high!</p> <p>Transfer is great for sports designs but consider artwork size. A large print may increase perspiration and feel heavy when worn.</p> <p>Look out for new and exciting eco versions.</p>	<p>100% Polyester is great for sublimation. A high level of detail can be achieved, as the inks become a part of the fabric, our Recycled Polyester maintains its lightweight and soft hand feel.</p> <p>Avoid ghosting by using thermal tape to keep sublimation paper securely in place.</p> <p>Sublimation works best with whites or light colours. Monitor your temperature, polyester can burn and scorch if cured too high!</p> <p>*Consider your environmental impact – sublimation paper can only be used once and is not recyclable.</p>	<p>Our Recycled Polyester styles can be embroidered, however ensure you use a stabilizer on the inside of the garment, behind your embroidery and make sure your needle is smooth and sharp to avoid snagging!</p> <p>Consider your artwork, as a large amount of embroidery could cause some puckering around the design.</p>
